1. Must be a licensed teacher;
2. **Must have integrity;**
3. **Must be willing to serve;**
4. **Must exhibit relevant expertise;**
5. **Must have experience in the education sector;** and
6. Must not have been convicted of any administrative offense or any crime involving moral turpitude and has no pending administrative and/or criminal case.

5. Nominee's Proposed Vision, Mission and Goals for Teacher Education Council;
6. Certificates/Clearances from the following government agencies, obtained not more than three (3) months from the date of filing of the application, indicating the applicant has no pending administrative and/or criminal case:
 - National Bureau of Investigation (NBI)
 - Institution/Company where the applicant is presently employed
7. Duly accomplished CSC Form 212 made under oath;
8. Certificate of Employment specifying the number of years in teaching and in administrative position or Service Record
9. Certificate/Proof of:
 - Training
 - Awards and Recognition
 - Research and Publication in the last 5 years
 - Resource Speaker/ Lecturer /Accreditor or Quality Assurance Work
 - Community Involvement/ Affiliations in education-related organizations
