- 2. The ELLNA will be administered to all currently enrolled Grade 3 learners in public schools, while the NATG6 will be administered to all public and private schools, and learners will be sampled in each school. On the other hand, the NATG12 will be administered to all currently enrolled Grade 12 learners in public and private schools.
- 3. The ELLNA is to be administered at the end of Grade 3 as a key stage assessment to determine if students are meeting the learning standards in early language, literacy, and numeracy. The test is in a multiple-choice item format. Moreover, English, Filipino, and Mother Tongue shall be the languages for this assessment. 8. The NATG6 and NATG12 are exit assessments under the national assessment framework of the K to 12 Basic Education Program. These tests are designed to determine if Grade 6 and Grade 12 learners are meeting the learning standards in the Elementary and Senior High School (SHS) curriculum. The exit assessments shall cover 21st Century Skills (Problem-Solving, Information Literacy, and Critical Thinking) using learning areas in English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan as content in NATG6, and the core SHS learning areas of Science, Philosophy, Language and Communication, Media and Information Literacy, Mathematics, Humanities, Wika at Komunikasyon, and Social Science in NATG12. The test design is progressive in nature wherein test items measure varying levels of skills in a multiple-choice format using English and Filipino languages.
- 4. The National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA) will be administered to all Grades 7 to 10 learners for School Year 2023- 2024 in all public schools across country. This assessment tool intends to determine the effectiveness of the learning camp intervention on the learning proficiencies of participating learners before and after attending the said program.
- 5. Attached herewith is the list of activities relative to the administration of the various assessment programs for basic education.

Following are the Suggested activities in the conduct of Catch-Up/RRE Classes for Grades 12, 6 and 3 learners

a.) Implement shortened class program in adherence to DM 675 s. 2022 (Institutionalizing Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith), and conduct the 3 to 4 hours Remediation, Reinforcement and Enhancement (RRE) classes focusing on:

Grade 12

-SHS core learning areas (Languages and

Communication, Humanities, Mathematics, Science,

Philosophy)

Grade 6

- English, Filipino, Mathematics, Science, Araling

Panlipunan

Grade 3

- English, Filipino, Mother Tongue Grammar &

Listening, Mother Tongue Numeracy

- b.) Give daily 10-item pre and post-test.
- c.) Provide lectures and practice tests on least learned and not taught competencies.
- d.) Utilize test materials parallel to the NAT G12, NAT G 6 and ELLNA.
- e.) Utilize the Learning Activity Sheets and Self Learning Modules in the RRE
- f.) Tap the expertise of the Junior High School, Senior High School Teachers, and Education Program Supervisors as RRE facilitators.
- g.) Give awards or incentives to learners who are regularly attending RRE classes and getting good results.
- h.) Enrich the school-based feeding program.
- i.) Adopt a learner who are habitual absentees.

Guidelines on the conduct of Mock Test for Grade 6 and Grade 3.

(For the Mock Test for Grade 12, please see DM No. 14, s. 2024)

The following are the terms of reference of the persons involved in the conduct of the Mock Exam:

A. Education Program Supervisors:

- Prepare the table of specifications, test questionnaires and key answers of the learning areas assigned to them.
- Monitor the conduct of the mock examination.

B. Learning Resource Manager:

- Compile all the test materials and distribute the soft copies to the district testing coordinators.

C. Division Testing Coordinator:

- Coordinate with the LR Manager in the distribution of the soft copy of the test materials to the district testing coordinator.
- Gather, collect and consolidate district mock test results per learning area.

D. Public District Supervisors:

- Assign room examiners for the mock examination for Grades 6 and 3.
- Monitor the conduct of the mock examination.
- Facilitate the printing and reproduction of test materials and answer sheets.
- Facilitate the district consolidation of the MPS per learning area.

E. District Testing Coordinators:

- Distribute the test materials and answer sheets to the chief examiners.
- Gather, collect, and consolidate the MPS of the schools per learning area for submission to the Division Testing Coordinator.
- **F.** Chief Examiners: these are the school heads of elementary schools of both public and private.
- Receive test materials from the district testing coordinators and distribute the test materials to room examiners on the day of the examination.
