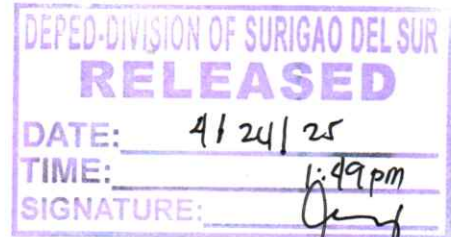

PARTICIPATION TO THE REGIONAL RETOOLING ON BEGINNING READING AND INSTRUCTION CUM ORIENTATION ON FUNCTIONAL LITERACY ASSESSMENT TOOLS FOR ALS TEACHERS AND VOLUNTEERS

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Caraga Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Regional Retooling on Beginning Reading and Instruction cum Orientation on Functional Literacy Assessment Tools for Alternative Learning System (ALS) Teachers and Volunteers as per Regional Memorandum No. 0354, s. 2025 . This initiative is aligned with the DepEd ALS Opportunity 2.0 Program, which aims to enhance literacy education for ALS learners.
2. The primary objectives of this training are as follows:
 - a. Enhance participants' ability to use differentiated instructional approaches in teaching reading in both Filipino and English, ensuring that literacy education is inclusive, accessible, and tailored to meet the diverse needs of ALS learners.
 - b. Develop the capacity of ALS teachers and volunteers to implement effective literacy instruction, focusing on strategies for teaching beginning reading that cater to the diverse and often non-traditional learning profile of ALS learners.
 - c. Provide ALS teachers and volunteers with practical training on the Functional Literacy Assessment Tool (FLAT) to accurately assess the literacy progress of ALS learners, ensuring data-driven and personalized interventions for reading improvement.
3. The training is to be conducted on May 1-3, 2025 in the Province of Surigao del Sur. Exact venue is to be announced in a separate memorandum. Participants are expected to arrive in the venue on April 30, 2025 for registration and orientation on the activity flow. Dinner is the first meal to serve on April 30, 2025 and afternoon snacks on May 3, 2025 is the last meal to serve.
