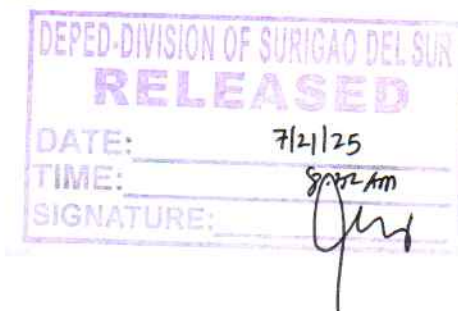

**CONDUCT OF MULTI-FACTORED ASSESSMENT TO GRADE 1 LEARNERS  
MANIFESTING DIFFICULTY IN LEARNING**

1. In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment to Inclusive Education (IE) and the proper identification and support of learners with diverse needs, all schools are directed to conduct Multi-Factored Assessment to Grade 1 learners manifesting consistent difficulties in learning, despite the implementation of appropriate classroom interventions. As mandated, this activity shall be conducted one (1) month after the opening of classes. Thus, the conduct will start from July 21 until August 1, 2025.
2. The purpose of this assessment is to gather comprehensive data on the learner's cognitive, academic, behavioral, social, and emotional functioning to better understand their needs and recommend appropriate educational placement, accommodations, or interventions.
3. Grade 1 teachers are hereby instructed to:
  1. Conduct and submit assessment result/s to their School Head, who shall summarize and forward report to the district MFAT Coordinator.
  2. Ensure secrecy of the result/s.
4. District MFAT Coordinator will summarize MFAT results and submit it to the Division SNED Focal, Analiza G. Doloricon on August 4-8, 2025.
5. Teachers, School Heads, and District MFAT Coordinator shall ensure confidentiality and accuracy of all data gathered.
