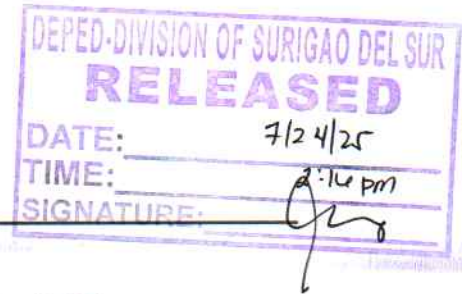

**ADOPTION AND ADMINISTRATION OF REGIONAL LEARNING
 GAP ASSESSMENT (RLGA)**

To: PSDSs/DICs
 All Concerned School Heads

1. Aligned with the Education Assessment and Research component of the Department of Education's National Quality Management System (NQMS), DepEd-Caraga implements the Regional Learning Gap Assessment (RLGA) Framework as stipulated in RM No. 0704, s. 2025.
2. The RLGA identifies learning gaps and evaluates learners' readiness for their current grade level, as well as their achievement of learning standards and 21st-century skills.
3. Following the test development protocol, Phase I pilot testing will be conducted within the testing window from July 28 to August 1, 2025. The results will be used solely to finalize the test forms and will not serve as a basis for comparing the performance of learners, schools, or Schools Division Offices.
4. Below is the list of sampled schools in SDO-Surigao del Sur along with their respective testing dates.

5. One school Computer Laboratory or any school facility with at least 33 laptops or tablets and internet connectivity must be identified as testing center (3 buffer computers are included). The technical specifications for the laptops, tablets and internet connectivity must be according to recent DepEd issuances (OUA MEMO 00-0622-0164)



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6. All testing personnel must strictly keep the integrity and confidentiality of the digital test materials per DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016 (Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program). Breach of security in systems assessment are subject to corresponding sanctions in reference to the said policy.
7. Attached herewith is the list of testing personnel assigned to each sampled school.
8. Expenses incurred in the administration of RLGA shall be charged against the program support funds (OSEC-13-25-00016) and/or local funds subject to government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
