SUBJECT: NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUBS SUMMIT

DATE: September 4, 2019

1. Every September of the year is the Science Club Month Celebration as mandated by Presidential Proclamation No. 264. This year's theme is "Metabolize: Nourishing the Filipino Youth towards National Wellbeing." Part of the month-long event is the National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT). This is a one -and - a-half- day gathering for Junior and Senior high school Science Clubbers and Teachers designed to reach out to regions and provide the Science Clubbing experience for those who are not able to attend the other national events conducted by Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC). This SUMMIT is composed of lectures, workshops and other exciting activities aimed at forwarding the thrust of the organization as well as developing camaraderie, leadership, and enthusiasm for science.

This year's SUMMIT for CARAGA Region Science Clubbers, along with the I TeachScience Seminar (ITSS) and the PSYSC Science Olympiad (PSO) National Eliminations, will be held in Lanuza, Surigao del Sur at Florita Herrera-Irizari National High School on September 7-8, 2019. With this, we would like to seek your support by disseminating this information to Science Teachers and High School Science Enthusiasts under your jurisdiction and encourage them to participate such science clubbing activities.

3. Participants are required to bring their own beddings.
4. Teacher-participants and Training Management Team shall be entitled of a 2-day service credits in accordance to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 re-Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with a 2-day Compensatory Time-off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and DBM Joint Circular No.2, s 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered.
5. Travelling expenses, per diems and registration fee of participants / club advisers shall be charged against other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Wide and immediate dissemination of the memorandum to all concerned is highly desired.
