

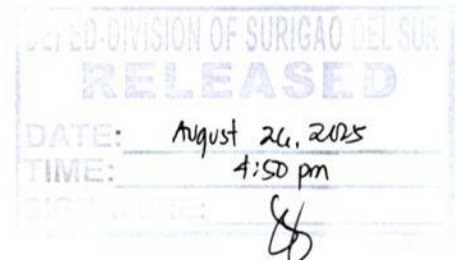

DIVISION ORIENTATION ON THE ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) SCHOOL-BASED LEARNING CENTER (SBLC)

1. The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE), continues to strengthen the implementation of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) to provide equitable and flexible basic education opportunities for out-of-school youth and adults (OSYA). A key strategy under the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum is the establishment of School-Based Learning Centers (SBLCs), which bring learning opportunities closer to communities.
2. In the Division of Surigao del Sur, the effective implementation of SBLCs requires clear understanding and coordination among ALS teachers, non-teaching personnel, school heads, and Public Schools District Supervisors/ District In Charge.
3. To equip ALS implementers with the necessary knowledge, skills, and tools to manage and operationalize SBLCs in line with national policies, ensuring quality and accessible education for all learners, a **DIVISION ORIENTATION ON THE ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) SCHOOL-BASED LEARNING CENTER (SBLC)** shall be conducted on September 5, 2025 in Gold Bar Hotel and Restaurant, Bag-ong Lungsod, Tandag City.
4. The objectives of the activity are as follows:
 - a. Understand the legal bases, objectives, and structure of ALS School-Based Learning Centers.
 - b. Familiarize with the roles and responsibilities of key stakeholders in the implementation of SBLCs.
 - c. Learn the standards, processes, and documentation required for establishing and managing SBLCs.
 - d. Develop initial plans for setting up and sustaining SBLCs in respective schools.
 - e. Promote collaboration between formal schools and ALS to support inclusive education.

5. Participants of the orientation are specified in the table below :

6. Participants shall bring laptop, extension wire and an approved copy of enrolment, class and teacher's program for School Year 2025-2026.
7. Expenses incurred on morning and afternoon snacks, lunch and supplies needed in the conduct of the activity shall be charged to ALS Program Support Fund (PSF) subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations. Transportation expenses of school personnel shall be charged to their School MOOE/Local Funds while the travelling expenses of PSDSs/DICs and ALS teachers shall be charged their local funds subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
