#### Dear Secretary Briones:

In 2021, the country will commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Victory at Mactan, the Philippine part in the first circumnavigation of the world, and other related events, collectively known as the 2021 Quincentennial Commemorations in the Philippines (2021 QCP). President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Executive Order No. 55, s. 2018 creating the National Quincentennial Committee (NQC) for this purpose.

One of the government initiatives for the 2021 QCP is to create a new soundtrack featuring new songs inspired by the milestones and their relevance to the present-day Filipinos. We call it Limandaan: The 2021 Quincentennial Commemorations in the Philippines. It contains nine OPM songs, identified through four 2019 PhilPop Bootcamps across the country. No less than National Artist for Music Ryan Cayabyab spearheaded the selection, with the help of veteran and emerging OPM artists.
