DENGUE AWARENESS MONTH 2021

To : District/School Nurses
This Division

1. Dengue is an acute viral infection that affects mostly young children and infants. It is the fastest spreading vector-borne disease in the world and is transmitted through a bite of dengue-infected *Aedes aegypti* and *Aedes albopictus* mosquitoes. It has been considered by the DOH as an all-year round disease which rises in incidence during the rainy season due to presence of more breeding places.
2. Dengue awareness month is observed every month of June by virtue of Proclamation no. 1204 signed last April 21, 1998 to build public awareness on the preventive measures against Dengue.
3. Anent to this, District/School nurses are required to conduct IEC activities on Dengue focusing on the preventive measures such as the 4-S campaign to their respective District/Schools. Reports for above activities must be submitted on or before the first week of July 2021 through the following link <https://tinyurl.com/SDS-DENGUE-AWARENESS>.
4. Compliance to the existing IATF protocols and minimum public health standards must be observed for face to face activity. Virtual/remote modality is highly encouraged.
