## RECOGNITION OF SCHOOL BASED FEEDING PROGRAM BENEFICIARY SCHOOLS WHO COMPLETED 120 FEEDING DAYS OF IMPLEMENTATION

- To: Public Schools District Supervisor Elementary School Heads School Based Feeding Program Coordinator
- The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learners Support Services - School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), implemented School Based Feeding Program (SBFP) to address undernutrition among public school children.
