This Division

- Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 24, 1994 and DepEd Memorandum No. 177, s. 2017 declaring the month of November of every year as Filipino Values Month and all other observances mandated in DepEd Order No. 07, s. 2020 which is amended by DepEd Order No. 30, s. 2020, this office conceived of integrating all the activities in a month-long virtual production anchored on the theme "Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin, Kalusuga'y Kalingain, Pagbabasaý Ugaliin".
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - a. create moral awakening and national consciousness on human values that are unique, genuine and positively Filipino;
 - sustain and revitalize the practice of caring for others, treating others with respect and dignity and assisting others to become better persons starting from the family;
 - support and sustain the services in the Barkada-adopted concepts among educators, families, peer groups and other sectors; and
 - d. promote love for reading
- The month-long celebration shall be done in four phases with specific timelines to avert overlapping of activities as shown below;

MECHANICS

1. Each unit must have one participant.

2. Each participant must bring a meaningful object from home (e.g. pictures or memorabilia, etc.) that can be related to the theme of the celebration.

Participants must introduce the object in 1 to 2 minutes.

4. The presentation of the participants must be pre-taped and must be submitted on November 13, 2020.

5. Decision of the board of judges is final.

MECHANICS

- 1. Each unit must have one participant only.
- 2. Each participant may submit up to five (5) photos that is original and unpublished.
- 3. All submissions must be accompanied with a narrative/description/caption relevant to the theme highlighted in the image.
- 4. The photo essay must be layed out through MS Word and must be submitted through PDF file on November 13, 2020.
- 5. Decision of the board of judges is final.

CRITERIA

Technique (the approach used to create the image)	20%
Composition (how all the visual elements harmoniously express the purpose or intent of the image)	20%
Presentation (the finished look)	20%
Center of Interest (the point(s) in the photo)	20%
Connections (the relevance to the theme)	20%
TOTAL	100%

INTERPRETATIVE READING

MECHANICS

- 1. The piece must be original and must revolve around the theme of the celebration. The piece must be in English language.
- 2. Each unit must have one representative either a male or a female.
- 3. Participants must wear school uniform. No other props and costume should be used in reading; therefore, digital sound effects and sound effects from musical instruments will not be allowed. Also, presentations for background will not be allowed.
- 4. Acting the piece out is not necessary. On the other hand, the readers should be able to portray all characters and their emotions through variation of voice.

CRITERIA

Projection of Characters (The reader is able to portray all characters and 100% of their emotions in all parts of the story.	20%
Voice Quality The reader uses proper volume, tone variation, and timing to show expression and feelings of the characters.	20%
Pronunciation The reader pronounces all the sounds and words properly in the entire story.	20%
Effectiveness Multiple techniques are used to artfully and successfully create audience interest.	20%
Relevance to the theme The reader connects the content to the theme.	20%

MISTER AND MISS Q AND A

MECHANICS

- There must be a pair of participants per unit: 1 male and one 1 female in any grade levels of the Junior High School.
- Contestants must wear school uniform during the contest.
- Each contestant will be given 1-minute to present their speech/answer
 which will be drawn from the questions given by the host. Once the bell
 rings, the contestant will now stop his speech. Filipino language must be
 used in delivering the speech.
- This contest will be done online on November 20, 2020. Contestants will just get into the link provided to them during the contest proper. The recorded footage will be shown on November 23, 2020.
- Questions will revolve on this year's theme.
- 6. Decision of the Board of Judges is final.

 There must be one participant per unit either a male or a female in any grade levels of the Senior High School.

- Each contestant will be given 3-4 minutes to present the spoken material
 which is pre-taped already. Filipino language must be used in delivering the
 material.
- 4. Pre-taped materials will be submitted on or before November 24, 2020.
- Contents of the spoken poetry will revolve on this year's theme.
- Decision of the Board of Judges is final.

CRITERIA

Relevance to the theme -	50%
Creativity/Style and Originality -	30%
Coherence of form and structure	
(harmony of words, presentation) -	10%
Clarity of imagery and language -	10%
TOTAL	100%

JINGLE-MAKING CONTEST

MECHANICS

- Each unit must have one entry regardless if it is performed by a single person or a group.
- 2. The jingle entries' theme must revolve into Strong Family Ties.
- 3. Entries may be accompanied by musical score or live instrumentals.
- 4. Language must be in English.
- Length of Jingle should not be less than 1 minute 30 seconds and not more than 2 minutes 30 seconds, including musical accompaniment. Excess presentation will be subjected for a 1-point deduction every 5 seconds on the total score.
- 6. Audio output will be submitted on November 24, 2020.
- 7. Decision of the Board of Judges is final.
