FINAL REITERATION OF THE VARIOUS OPTIONS OF LEARNING RESOURCE (LR) PROVISION UNDER THE NEW NORMAL SETTING

To: Public Schools District Supervisors & Districts In-Charge Elementary and Secondary School Heads This Division

- 1. In order to cater all learners in the provision of learning resources and put everything in place during the opening of classes on October 5, 2020, the Schools Division Office (SDO) is hereby reiterating on the various LR options to be utilized by the schools.
 - A. Modules

Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) – Central Office-released MELC-based learning resources that shall be used for school year 2020-2021. To facilitate timely provision of SLMs for the 1st quarter, the schools through the MOOE, are authorized to set the print run based on the quantity needed. The SDO also has allotted 24 million pesos for procurement of bond papers, to be delivered to schools at the soonest possible time to augment the printing and reproduction logistics. As with the 2nd quarter SLMs, the SDO shall engage in procurement and in-house printing and delivery to schools.

The SLMs will be integrated to various learning delivery modalities such as TV-based instruction, radio-based instruction and online. Kindergarten to Grade 3 SLMs are regionally-contextualized and is an ongoing endeavor.

<u>PPE exemplars</u> – Locally developed self-learning modules that shall be utilized in the first 2 weeks of the first quarter. It shall then be used as supplementary learning resource to the SLMs in the succeeding weeks until all available exemplars will be expended. If the printing and reproduction budget will not warrant to have PPE exemplars as supplementary LR, then it shall be the school's prerogative on which MELC-based module to print, reproduce and distribute.

For Grades 1 to 3 Sinugbuanong Binisaya, Senior High School and OTHER subjects not available in the PPE exemplars, schools shall have the option in using SLMs, books with activity sheets, teacher-developed modules and other forms of MELC-based learning resources.

B. Books

The Learner's Materials (LMs) and Textbooks (TXs) remain as a serviceable learning resource paired with activity sheets. The Regional Office (RO) has consolidated the MELC mapping in all available books in the schools. The inventory and budget of work could be downloaded from the Division local portal *LRlinked Surigao del Sur*, to be sorted under Teaching Materials.

C. Combination of Modules and Books

The RO has <u>suggested</u> a prototype combination of subjects in all grade levels through the issuance of Regional Memorandum No. 363, s. 2020. The combination of textbooks with Weekly Learning Plan & Activity Sheets and CO/locally developed SLMs is divided into 2 sets monthly in order to prevent exchanging of materials by the students. Please see the memorandum herewith for clarification.

- 2. Consistent with DepEd Order No. 17 s. 2020, while private schools are encouraged to avail of the SLMs in aid of the teaching and learning processes, as SLMs are government property, written from the Department of Education is required (Memorandum DM-CI-2020-00235).
- 3. Distribution of modules and other school-preferred learning resources shall materialize on October 2, 2020.
- 4. Subject to the unique context of the school and its learning delivery modality, the provision of the various learning resources shall be strategic, anchored on learner-centeredness, cost efficiency and health safety protocols.
- 5. For widest dissemination, guidance, and immediate compliance.

- 5. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall adopt other appropriate modalities depending on the number of students and teachers in schools and the availability of SLMs and textbooks.
