**SURIGAO DEL SUR DIVISION POLICY ON THE DEPLOYMENT OF DEPED
HEALTH PERSONNEL**

Section 9 of Executive Order no. 14, s. 2020 directed DepEd Health Personnel to augment the RHU personnel at entry/exit points of the province as a measure of control.

DepEd Health Personnel may be deployed to assist the checkpoints established by the Province in the entry/exit points in Surigao del Sur provided that:

- a) **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be given** by their respective LGU.
- b) Proper training/orientation will be done prior to deployment.
- c) Transportation means to respective assignments especially to those with no personal vehicle.
- d) Deployment will have maximum of 2 working days per week on a day shift with 8 hours duration so that School/District nurse will still have time to comply with the reports/consolidated school health related data. Weekend duty is not allowed.

In compliance to DepEd Order no. 043, s. 2020 Health Personnel who are at high risk for infections including but not limited to pregnant women; age 60 years and above; Persons under Monitoring (PUM) or Persons Under Investigation (PUI); and personnel with pre-existing medical conditions including Hypertension and other Cardiovascular Diseases, Diabetes Mellitus, Cancer, Bronchial Asthma and other Chronic Lung Diseases, Renal Disease and Immunocompromised **are exempted.**

In case additional compensation/benefits will be provided to front liners deployed in response to COVID-19, DepEd Health Personnel deployed are to be included.
