Being mandated by Republic Act No. 9155 otherwise known as the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001, the Department of Education (DepEd) had already undertaken education researches that served as bases for necessary reform and development contained in DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2015-The Policy Development Process; DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2016- Adoption of Basic Education Research Agenda; and DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017- The Research Management Guidelines. These provisions have guided all governance levels to strengthen processes and systems towards evidence-based decision making.

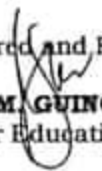

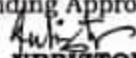

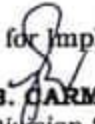
